

Westside Christian School
Tuition Schedule and Scholarships
2020-21

Westside Christian School receives its income from tuition and fees, not from State or Federal funds. Therefore, it is important that all tuition and fees be paid when due. The facilities are provided by Westside Baptist Church without cost to the school ministry.

Tuition rates to be re-evaluated by the WCS board of directors annually and subject to change.

New Student Registration Fee \$50 (not refundable)

Scholarship Opportunities (only one of the following scholarships can be applied per family)

Church Member – at least one parent/grandparent who is paying the tuition is an active member of Westside Baptist Church who faithfully attends and participates in church ministries and tithes. This scholarship is automatically applied and takes into account the fact that Westside Members are helping pay for the facility overhead costs through their tithes and offerings. Exceptions to this can be considered for Jr. High/High school students who choose to join the church on their own and faithfully attend and tithe.

Tuition Assistance Program (TAP) – a household income based scholarship. An application for this scholarship can be filled out any time during the school year, but the discounts will not be applied retroactively. Household income refers to the income that the parents or custodial parent is required to report to the IRS as income.

Tier 1 Household income ... \$75,000 – \$100,000 = 10 percent discount

Tier 2 Household income \$50,000 – \$75,000 = 15 percent discount

Tier 3 Household income \$0 – \$50,000 = 20 percent discount

Work Scholarship – parent(s) and/or student perform assigned duties on a regular basis throughout the school year (e.g. custodial duties, teacher assistant, building maintenance). This scholarship amount will be discussed on an individual basis and agreed upon together.

Abundant Giving Scholarships as available (available to any family in addition to other scholarships)

As funds are given from outside sources, the school administration/board can award these scholarships at will. Funds are distributed solely at the discretion of the school administration/board.

1. **Job's Trials** – for those who are experiencing unusually burdensome trials (Job 1:1, 8, 20-22)
2. **Do Not Lose Heart** – for those who are laboring diligently or are attempting to carry an unusually heavy responsibility and would be greatly blessed with a gift of temporal encouragement (Galatians 6:1-10)
3. **Book Fee Scholarship** – a scholarship that is applied toward the book fees required each year.

WCS offers three payment methods for its families:

Plan 1 – Pay the annual tuition in full by the September due date and receive a 1% discount

Plan 2 – Pay by using a monthly payment plan based on a nine-month schedule beginning September 1 with the last payment due May 1

Plan 3 – Pay by using a monthly payment plan based on a twelve-month schedule beginning June 1 with the last payment due May 1

Please note: credit card payments are accepted, but an additional fee will be required.

Also note: A \$15.00 late charge will be assessed on all Plan 2 and Plan 3 accounts not received by the 15th of each month. If a situation arises which prohibits payment of an account, it is the responsibility of the parents to notify the school principal, in order to request a possible payment extension.
