

## TUITION RATES FOR 2024-2025 SCHOOL YEAR

KINDERGARTEN ½ Day	1 <sup>st</sup> – 12 <sup>th</sup> GRADE
\$4,500	\$7,000

An additional \$50 registration fee is paid at the time of enrollment.

Tuition includes rental of all school-owned textbooks, purchase of consumable textbooks, and field trip fees. It does not include school uniforms, physical education uniforms, or costs associated with parties and special activities. The rental books must be cared for and turned in at the end of the year. Fines may be assessed at the end of the year based on the condition of the book(s).

### Payment Plans

Ten month – August-May (due the first of each month)

One payment – due August 15th

Two payments – due August 15th and January 15th

**Advanced payment discount** – 1% discount given to families who pay their entire tuition balance for the year or semester. If you choose to pay by semester, the discount will be applied at the beginning of each semester on the half of the tuition paid. To qualify for the 1% discount, the tuition due must be paid during the first week of the semester. This discount does not apply if a family uses Utah's Fits All Scholarship.

**Utah Fits All Scholarship** – we encourage all parents to apply for the scholarship program so that you can maximize the benefits it includes. Please note that the window for the 2024-2025 school year applications is open only from February 28, 2024-April 15, 2024.

**Tuition Assistance Program (TAP)**- a household income-based scholarship. An application for this scholarship can be filled out any time during the school year, but the scholarships will not be applied retroactively. Household income refers to the income that the parents or custodial parent is required to report to the IRS as income.

Tier 1 Household income ... \$75,000 - \$100,000 = 35% Scholarship

Tier 2 Household income ... \$50,000 - \$75,000 = 40% Scholarship

Tier 3 Household income ... \$0 - \$50,000 = 45% Scholarship
